The Association `Today's Students, Tomorrow's Leaders` is acknowledging the dire situation with the representation at the local and national level of the youth voice, and fought in 2024 for greater representation through the creation of Local Youth Councils, Advisory Committies and National Consultative Youth Councils.

The Association is a permanent member of the National Consultative Youth Council of Romania, while chairring the Committe for Social Inclussion and members of the Education and Employment and Entrepreneurship.

The organization implemented internal policies in regard to social inclussion and gender equality by promoting a safe space. Moreover, we focused on providing adequate means of education and development for persons with disabilities.

The Association 'Today's Students, Tomorrow's Leaders' emphatised on implementing social policies in the community by organizing projects to rise awareness on the importance of diversity and inclussion in public and work spaces.

The Association `Today's Students, Tomorrow's Leaders` was involved in key international and european conferences with the aim to enhance our vision, and represent the romanian youth voice.


The Conferences and Meeting we attended:

- 3. `Global Peace Summit New York`, organized by Globa Peace Chain.


Financial Summary

In 2024, the Association attracted aproximatly 20.000 euros in revenus. The following charts will ellaborate:




The majority of funds raised for the year came from public entities
